As long as they are not a guard going through training they don't have time to do. The other was given a burial at sea. On the following day, Armistice Day, the casket was placed in a caisson and transported to Arlington National Cemetery. During the winter months, from October 1 to March 31, the guard is changed every hour from October 1 to March. Soldiers in training may guard the tomb and perform their duties just as a sentinel, but only a sentinel may wear the badge.
